RESOLUTION NO. __2020-3A____ Amendment to 2020-3 Video and Teleconference Meeting Authorization

The Town Board of the Town of Long Lake-Florence County does hereby resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus pandemic has created an enormous public health crisis; and

WHEREAS, Florence County, the Governor of the State of Wisconsin and the Federal Government have all declared public emergencies to confront this pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board is desirous of putting in place a method by which it may meet either through videoconference or teleconference means;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Town of Long Lake-Florence County shall permit the use of videoconferencing or teleconferencing to allow meetings of the Town Board or Committees of the Town Board to occur.
- 2. That the Town of Long Lake-Florence County shall permit members of the board to attend meetings via videoconferencing or teleconferencing with a required 24 hours advance notice given to the Town Clerk.
- 3. That the Town Clerk is directed to provide that either a videoconference or a teleconference shall permit access to those meetings by the general public.
- 4. That the Town Clerk is hereby directed to post in any meeting notice an agenda which will be conducted via teleconference or videoconference, the directions to the general public on how to connect to the meeting and further, shall note in the notice of the meeting and agenda that the meeting will be held via teleconferencing or videoconferencing.
- 5. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Town Board and shall remain in effect until further Resolution or Ordinance of the Town Board of the Town of Long Lake-Florence County.
